- As an organization we are committed to providing a safe and educational environment where children can participate in the sports of football and cheerleading.
- As volunteers your role in the organization is vital to provide the safest environment for the children.
- Be a positive influence on ALL children within the organization.
- Alert organization of any health or medical concerns immediately and follow the COVID-19 Guidelines.
- Support all the decisions made by the Board of Directors as well as the coaching staff.
- Will not participate in any unbecoming conduct at any Riverside Jr. Vikings event.
- Will not engage in any inappropriate behavior towards the coaching staff, referee, or opposing coaching staff.
- Will not use inappropriate or profane language at any time during the season or at any Riverside Jr. Vikings event.
- Will accept all decisions made by the officials and league officers.
- Will refrain from any inappropriate behavior on any social media platform and will abide by the ACCJFL and Riverside Junior Vikings Organization social media policy.
- Agree to take responsibility for any violations of the parent code of conduct or the Bylaws of the organization.
- Participate in all mandatory fundraisers held by the organization.
- Will not use any tobacco or alcohol products on the property of the organization.
- Will commit to 2 shifts at the concession stand and volunteer for events or field prep when available.
- I am not permitted to be on the field unless I am a volunteer and have submitted all my clearances.
- Follow the proper chain of command with any questions, comments or concerns I may have.
- The chain of command regarding the sport my child is participating in is outlined Below.
 - 1. Speak with the Head Coach
 - 2. Speak with the Football or Cheer Coordinator
 - 3. Speak with a member of the Board of Directors.
- I Understand the Riverside Jr. Vikings follows their bylaws when determining the best course of action for the organization.
- I can approach my child's coach before or after practice.
- I can only discuss playing time or participation time with my child's coach after 24hrs has passed after a game or competition.
- I understand it is my responsibility to provide the transportation needed for my child to participate in the organization.

- I understand my child's attendance can / will affect their playing time for games/ and or placement for competition.
- It is my responsibility to provide the equipment needed for my child to participate.
- I understand I have responsibilities to the organization and am required to pay a uniform deposit fee when the uniform is issued to my child. I understand that in order to receive my FULL deposit back I MUST do the following:
 - 1. ALL uniform components returned in the same or better condition.
 - 2. Complete 2 shifts at concession stand during games, or chains during the games.
 - 3. Participate in at LEAST 2 organization fundraisers or donate to the stand, bake sale or basket raffles.
 - 4. Parent, Child, and Coaches code of conduct is not broken at any time during the season.
 - 5. Uniforms should be returned at designated uniform dates TBA, but absolutely MUST be returned NO LATER THAN November 30, 2023.
- If I should violate any of the above stated guidelines, I understand there will be appropriate repercussions for my actions.
 - 1. 1^{st} offense verbal warning
 - 2. 2nd offense written warning.
 - 3. 3rd offense expulsion from organization and behavior / conduct reported to the ACCJFL and the Riverside Jr. Vikings will follow their decision.
- Going directly to the ACCJFL without discussing your dissatisfaction with the Organization results in immediate banishment from the organization.

I affirm and agree with the above stated guidelines and will respect and follow the rules and bylaws of the Riverside Jr. Vikings and the ACCJFL. Failure to abide by the guidelines will result in the appropriate action taken to ensure the safety and wellbeing of the children and volunteers of the organization.
