

Social Media Policy

SOCIAL MEDIA The ACCJFL and Riverside Junior Vikings Organization will enforce zero tolerance for any derogatory comments made on social media, team websites, or any public forum, by all ACCJFL members. Allegations of violation of the ACCJFL social media policy shall be presented to the Board for investigation. The Board at a special meeting called for that purpose shall make a determination, and when appropriate sanctions as prescribed in the bylaws up to and including a permanent ban from participation with any ACCJFL organization shall be imposed (see Article XVII Penalties of ACC Bylaws).

The ACC Board of Directors reserves the right to impose any penalty it determines to be appropriate based on the severity of a violation of any provision of these Bylaws.

TEAM:

1. Forfeiture of Game

COACH:

1. Verbal Reprimand
2. One Game Suspension
3. Suspension for remainder of season (Not Less Than Three (3) Games)
Suspension(s) may carry into following season.
4. Expulsion from ACCJF. (Requires a 2/3 two thirds affirmative vote of the Board) Any coach that is verbally reprimand three (3) times during a season shall receive a one game suspension.

OTHERS: Parents, Team Officials, Spectators, Volunteers, Players, Cheerleaders ETC.

1. Expulsion from attending ACCJF games or functions.

The Riverside Junior Vikings Football and Cheer Organization implement, follow and enforce this social media policy.
